## Additional Information for the 2009-2010 Calendar

### Student Contact Days (177/178 Days) and Inclement Weather

In the state of Missouri, students are required to attend 174 days and one thousand forty-four hours. North Kansas City Schools is committed to 177 student attendance days. Recent legislation requires six make-up days for inclement weather. We already had three in our calendar. An additional three days have been added at the end of the school year to meet state requirements. If we have no more than three inclement weather days, school will be dismissed three days early. Staff members should not make vacation and travel plans prior to May 28 in case these days are needed.

### Transition Day for Grades K, 6, and 9

All staff is on duty for the transition day. Site plans should be generated that involves all staff. Transition day has been scheduled for Monday. All other grades will start Tuesday.

### Parent/Teacher/Student Conferences

The conference window for K-5 and 9-12 sites is from October 15 - November 2. The middle school window is from October 1- November 2. Principals should work with Site-Based Councils to develop the conference schedule. Two early release days on October 29 and 30 have been provided for release/conference time. These hours may be used unless the site arranges an alternative schedule to meet parent needs. These two half-days and an additional contract day is the equivalent of two teacher work days or fifteen hours that are to be scheduled for parent/teacher conferences outside of the school day when students are not in school.

All parents of elementary students should be contacted and/or scheduled for a conference regarding student progress. Please keep in mind that all parents of secondary students should be invited and have the opportunity to conference with teachers. Documentation of parent attendance is required as principals will submit a percentage of participation for the district's public report.

### Explanation of Days

Building collaboration days are included in the district calendar. These days should be reserved for grade level, department, or building planning and other work. Two, half-days (K-12) are provided at the end of each semester. These days provide time for teachers to complete work. Please note that these days are regular contract hours for staff.
